Keeping European consumers safe is the mission of the European Rapid Alert System for non-food dangerous products (RAPEX).

The RAPEX system ensures that information about dangerous products is quickly shared between all EU market surveillance authorities and therefore protective measures can be taken in those countries where such products are found.

Since its implementation ten years ago, the number of notifications disseminated by RAPEX as well as the cooperation and exchange of information between national authorities and the European Commission has been continuously growing. This has contributed to an increased level of safety for European consumers.

The documents follow a new approach with the intention to highlight, especially in the national factsheets, the overall alerts (i.e. the total of notifications and follow-up actions) considered to be better representative of a country's total RAPEX activity. Moreover, the statistics refer to notifications on serious risks, other risks level and for information – altogether.
